Candlewood Knolls Golf Cart Guidelines:

- Golf Carts must have headlights and reflective tape affixed to the rear of the cart if they are going to be used after dark. (Reflective tail tape will be provided.)
- Drivers must be 16 years of age to drive a Golf Cart or 15 years of age with a valid learners permit. You may also drive a Golf Cart if you are under the age of 16 if you are accompanied by an adult, 21 years of age or older, sitting alongside in the front seat.
- Golf Cart capacity is limited to the available seating on each respective Golf Cart.
- Driving rules for Golf Carts are consistent with the general rules of the road. This includes abiding by stop signs, yielding right of way, staying to the right side of the road, etc. It is the responsibility of the driver to know and follow the rules of the road.

Happy Memorial Day everyone! We are looking forward to the start of another great summer at Candlewood Knolls. Welcome back to those of you returning to CK, and hello to our friends who lived through another winter in the Northeast.

The street cleaning has been completed so we say goodbye to the cold months and welcome in the warmer weather! Now begins the rest of the cleanup including weeding, planting and mulching. Dan and his staff have begun to tackle this task and will continue throughout the season.

The board has accomplished a lot in the last year with help of Dan Hamilton and our new Administrative Assistant Siobhan. We completely renovated the kitchen in the clubhouse including new flooring, cabinets, countertops, dishwasher, sink and workstation. We started the permit process for the basement renovations and we plan to start the project in the fall. We replaced the damaged flooring in the finished side of the basement which added a whole new look and better acoustics. We have repaired the damage to the docks at club beach that occurred over the winter. We are planning to pave the next two roads in our cycle, the lower half of Candlewood Knolls and Summer Hill, and make repairs to the needed areas throughout the community. We have contracted with a more experienced security company this year while working within the same budget as previous years.

The community remains in a strong financial position while we continue to build up our reserves and care for our infrastructure.

Florence Iavarone has been busy as usual putting together a full entertainment calendar as noted under upcoming events and on the calendar on our website.
