## Candlewood Knolls Golf Cart Guidelines:

- Golf Carts must have headlights and reflective tape affixed to the rear of the cart if they are going to be used after dark. (Reflective tail tape will be provided.)
- Drivers must be 16 years of age to drive a Golf Cart or 15 years of age with a valid learners permit. You may also drive a Golf Cart if you are under the age of 16 if you are accompanied by an adult, 21 years of age or older, sitting alongside in the front seat.
- Golf Cart capacity is limited to the available seating on each respective Golf Cart.
- Driving rules for Golf Carts are consistent with the general rules of the road. This includes abiding by stop signs, yielding right of way, staying to the right side of the road, etc. It is the responsibility of the driver to know and follow the rules of the road.

## A Message from your Board of Directors

To All Community Members:

We have had an issue with the feral cat population at Candlewood Knolls for some time. Board members, and several community volunteers, have had dialog with a few experts and there is no easy solution to this problem. The experts tell us one thing is certain: people who are feeding the feral cat population and not taking the extra step of capturing these animals and turning them over to the appropriate authorities are making matters much worse, potentially causing a severe health hazard (not to mention the property damages these wild cats have created throughout our community).

Everyone is urged to STOP feeding feral cats. They are NOT domestic pets. The Board is working with representatives from the Town of New Fairfield to determine an action plan, which we hope to be able to communicate to CK residents throughout the summer and fall.

In the meantime, your cooperation would be appreciated.
