Although many of these cats have been vaccinated thanks to some kind Knolls residents, not every animal has been. Raccoons, squirrels and other animals should not be touched. Please do not take measures in your own hands and move or destroy any animal. Many household cats are allowed outdoors

and are properly vaccinated. The best rule is: if you don't own it, don't touch it! If you see an animal acting strangely, please call Animal Control.

The first ice cream night of the season will be on Wednesday, June 29th at 7:30. Come one down for this popular night.

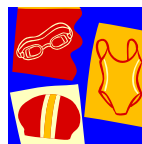


The first Sunfish Race of the season will be held on Sunday, July 3rd at South Beach.
